



## Safety guidelines

*Starlight's summer Motomax is a fun activity that all of our families enjoy. Starlight takes pride in providing a safe environment for you and your family. To ensure everyone has a safe and fun adventure on the water we ask that you please read our boating safety guidelines below.*

1. Every child under the age of 13 must wear a life jacket at all times. Passengers over the age of 13 should have a life jacket in their hands or close by. Life jackets are provided by Starlight on the boat.
2. Make sure you stay seated while the boat is moving. If you need anything, wait until the boat slows down or ask the Starlight staff on board for help.
3. Listen to your captain and the Starlight staff on board
4. When in the water, stay clear of the Engines.
5. Never board or exit the boat from the water when engines are on—or idling.
6. Wait for the boat to be stopped and docked and make sure the captain gives the go before exiting the boat.
7. Make sure you wear appropriate clothing while on board. Don't forget to put your sunscreen on before coming on board.
8. Secure all loose objects to avoid them flying away (hats, glasses, etc).
9. All bags should be secured in the different compartments of the boat.
10. Our pontoon does not have a fridge or toilet on board. Please be prepared before going on board.
11. Have fun and enjoy the outing on the water!
